Lunches

School dinners cost £2.34 per day for those who need to pay. All dinners must be paid for on the day or in advance via the online SCOpay system. If you don't have a SCOpay account, please let the front office know and they will help you. Children in Reception and year 1 and 2 get free school meals - Universal Infant Free School Meals (UISFM). All families can apply for free school meals (FSM) if they think they are eligible. If you are not sure it's worth applying as for every FSM child the school gets additional funds to spend on your child.

If you know your child is going to be late to school, please inform the office of their lunch choice before 9.30am otherwise you may need to provide a packed lunch. If your child has any special dietary needs (e.g. No dairy, no soya) then please contact the office and we can arrange with Caterlink a menu catered to your child's needs.

The menu for Autumn term can be found on our website under the 'Parent' pencil.

Playtime snacks

We encourage children to have healthy snacks at playtime. We will provide fruit or veg for KS1 children every day from next week. For KS2, you can bring in your own fruit, veg, plain biscuits or plain rice cakes. No crisps, chocolate or cereal bars for playtime snack.

Water bottles

We have provided water bottles for all of our new children including those in Year R.so they do not need to bring one in. For everyone else, please provide your own labelled bottle. Many thanks!

Farlington Wrap Around Service

In September we are continuing to offer after school care for 3 to 11 year olds from after school to 6pm. (3 year old Nursery children to Year 6) This will be run by Farlington Wrap Around Service.
