

# **English**

We will write a recount of some of these journeys using our Year 4 writing skills. Our main focus will be on using sentence patterns for effect, paragraphs and writing cohesively.

## Geography

As geographers we will be comparing and contrasting our local region of 'Cosham' with the region of the New Forest. We will identify human and physical features of both areas before analysing economic activity.

## Spanish

As linguists this half term we will be learning how to describe feeling unwell and symptoms of illnesses in Spanish whilst revising parts of the body too.

As designers this half term we will be baking scones in honour of the King's coronation

# Maths

As mathematicians this half term, we will be revisiting place value in numbers with up to four digits. We will apply our knowledge of addition and subtraction in different contexts before moving on to revisiting multiplication and division.

In Computing this half term, we are learning how we can use computers to collect data and also what we can learn from this data.
