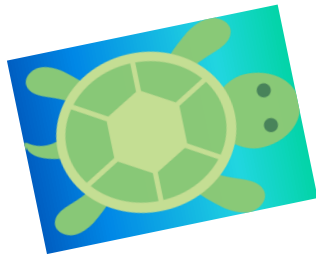


# TINY TIM

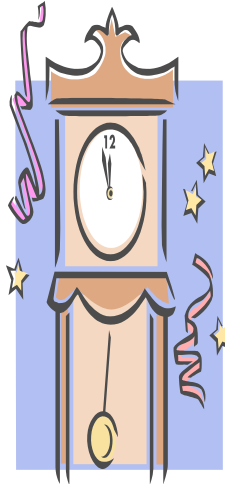

## DINGLE DANGLE SCARECROW



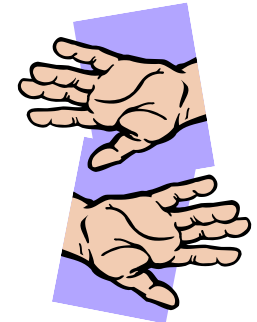
When all the cows are

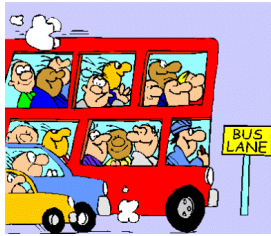

All through the town.

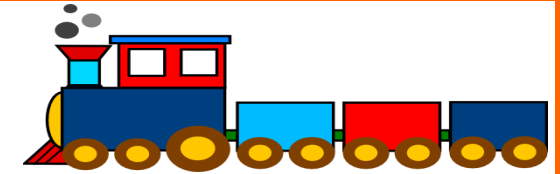
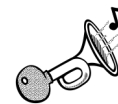


The driver on the bus says Move On Back!

All through the town.

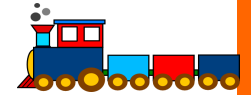


*Additional verses or make up your own!*

The mummy on the bus goes chatter, chatter, chatter...

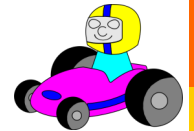


## My Little Engine

But still it wouldn't go.

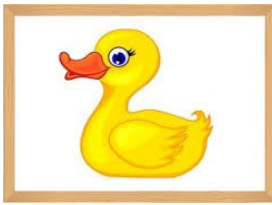


I had a little aeroplane

came back.

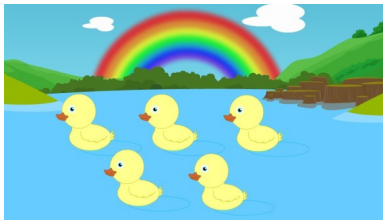
Four little ducks.....

came back.



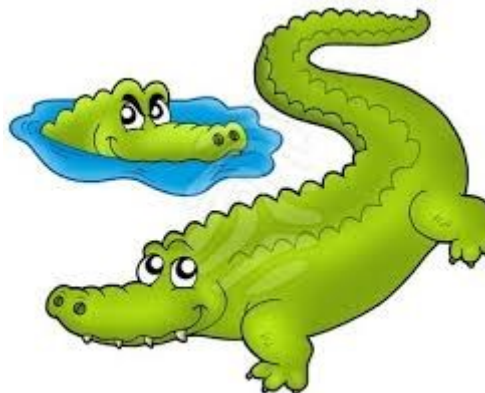
## Row Row Row your Boat

Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall.

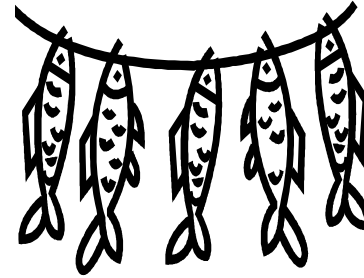
Humpty Dumpty had a great fall.

All the king's horses and all the king's men.

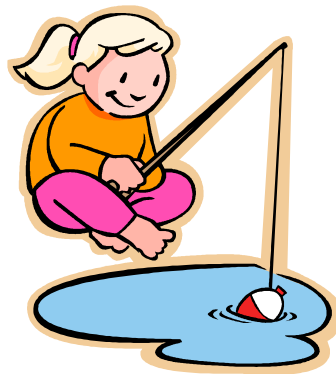
Couldn't put Humpty together again.
