The driver on the bus says Move On Back! Move On back! Move On Back! The driver on the bus says Move On Back! All through the town.


The people on the bus go up and down, up and down, up and down. The people on the bus go up and down All through the town.

The horn of the bus goes beep beep beep.



I had a little motor car But it wouldn't go; I had to turn and turn and turn the key But still it wouldn't go.






I had a little aeroplane My aeroplane could fly I jumped right in, away I flew Right into the sky.

Daddy duck said, 'QUACK, QUACK, QUACK, QUACK'. And all the five little ducks came back.


