The children will be continuing to develop their fine motor skills and begin to practise forming long legged giraffes—I,i,t,y,u,j.






Maths

In Maths, the children will be practising their subitising skills (recognising amounts up to 5 without counting) and will be finding different ways of making 5.

They will be exploring different 2D shapes and creating simple repeating patterns.

Can you talk about your favourite story?

Communication and language

This term, we will be learning and using new vocabulary to describe and talk about autumn and different celebrations.

The children will be encouraged to use full sentences when talking.

Literacy

During this term, we will be listening to a range of stories about different celebrations and talking about what happened in the story and how it may link to our own experiences.

Phonics

In phonics, we will continue to learn the initial letter sounds and practise blending short words together to read, such as d-o-g dog.

Each week we will send home information on what the children have learnt that week.
