Home Learning

A fun few ways to practise spellings at home:

Snap!: Make small cards with spellings on them. Play snap

with them or turn them upside down and play find the pair!

Water Paint: Use water and a paintbrush to water paint the spelling words.

Stairs: Write the words as if they are stairs, adding one letter each time: S, Sp, Spe, Spel, Spell
