Welcome to Year 4! We are very excited to welcome you all back to school as we have lots of exciting things planned.


In this newsletter, you will find out more about all the things we will be learning about this term.

In PSHE, we will be thinking about 'Being Me in My World' and our role within the school community. We will spend time talking about our Class Charter so we can make sure our class is a great place to be and learn.

English

As writers this half term, we will be first reading The Tear Thief and using it to practise our amazing writing skills including basic sentence punctuation and simple story openers. We will then be investigating The White Fox and looking at how to add more detail into our

sentences for the reader. This book is set in Seattle and Alaska and deals with the theme of belonging.

Spanish

We will be learning how to introduce members of our family in Spanish. We will then learn how to describe features of our face in Spanish and putting colours with features such as eyes or hair.

Can you remember how to count to 20 in Spanish?

Maths

We will be revisiting place value from Year 3 and then extending our knowledge with numbers up to four digits. We will also revisit our knowledge of addition and subtraction and practise using number lines and column methods. We will then look at applying this through different problems. This year we will become fluent in all our times tables and to do this, we will need to practise every day.

Children can do this by logging into Mathsframe multiplication check

Science

As scientists, we will be investigating the relationship between solids, liquid and gases, classifying objects and identifying their properties. The children will work scientifically investigating melting and freezing.

Art

As artists this half term we will be investigating the use of different media used by artists and creating our own mixed media pictures.

Geography

This half term, our topic will be 'Natural Disasters.' We will look at the physical geography of the Earth and what causes earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanoes. We will also explore how these events affect people, communities and landscapes.
