

Here are some activities that you can do to support your Year 4 work today:

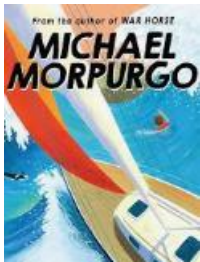
1. Practise spellings from our Year 4 spelling list:
