The children will continue to be supported to use the Zones of Regulation.


They will be talking about what they are good at and what they would like to get better at.

In PE sessions the focus is on building simple games.






Maths

The children will continue to explore ways of making numbers up to 5 and beyond, talking about the ways they have made. They will also practise subitising to 5.

Can you retell your favourite story?

Communication and language

This term we will be learning and using new vocabulary to describe and talk about different environments.

The children will be encouraged to explain their thinking

Literacy

During this term we will be listening to a range of stories about different celebrations and talking about what happened in the story and how it may link to our own experiences.

Phonics

In phonics this term the learning will be focusing on learning digraphs, these are 2 letters that make one sound, e.g. ee as in bee and ai as in pail.

Each week we will send home information on what the children have learnt that week.

Expressive Arts and design

The children will explore different ways of mixing paint, making it lighter, darker, thicker and thinner.

In Music they will be exploring and responding to different ways of making sounds.

Make as many different sounds as you can in one minute.

Understanding the World

The children will be talking about different places, from stories and our local area.

They will be exploring programmable toys called beebots, finding out how to program it to move.
