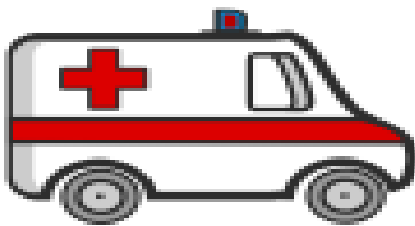
People Who Help Us!
