

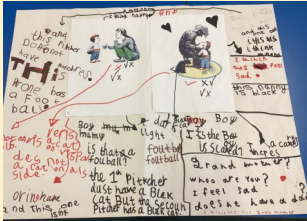

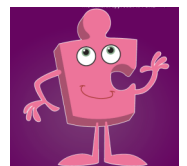

learn about the changes we go through in our lives and focusing on how our bodies change.

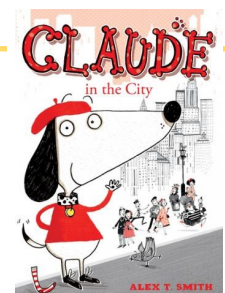


Can you think of 3 changes that have happened to you since you were born?

What is the best way for a Jew to show commitment to God?

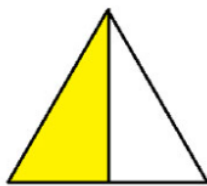


What people are important to you in your life?
