Spanish

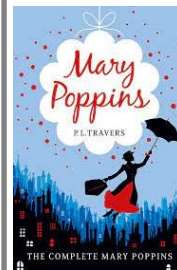


In Spanish we will be learning the names of some foods you take on a picnic

Reading



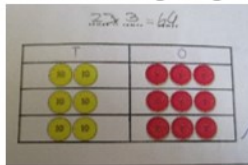
Miss Courtney is reading Mary Poppins—What books are you reading at home?

Maths

In maths, we will be continuing to practise our times tables and will revisit fractions.

The children will learn to multiply 2-digit numbers by a 1-digit number using the method of partitioning and grid arrays.

- Using PV counters to support understanding for grid method:



- Moving to grid method:
