The role play area will be set up like a classroom. Children will be able to act out the role of a teacher or pupil.

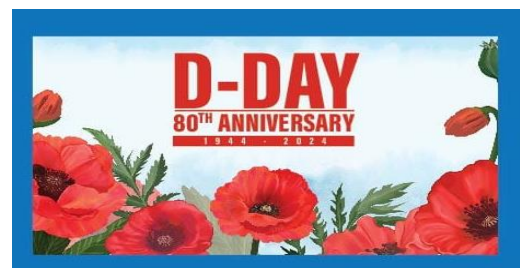
We will be encouraging children to talk about what they might do in school, what rules might be in school and what they might need, such as a book bag, lunch and uniform.
