We will also be sending home a story book for you to read with them.

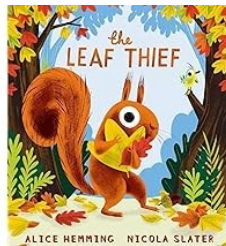
Personal and social development

The children will be continuing to develop their fine motor skills and begin to practice forming long legged giraffes—l,i,t,y,u,j.

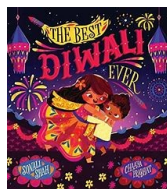
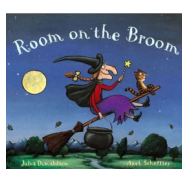
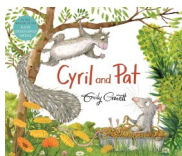
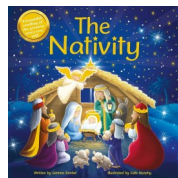
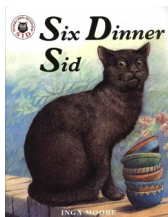


Maths

Communication and language

This term we will be learning and using new vocabulary to describe and talk about Autumn and different celebrations.

The children will be encouraged to use full sentences when talking.

Literacy

Phonics

In phonics, we will continue to learn the initial letter sounds and practise blending short words together to read, such as d-o-g dog.
