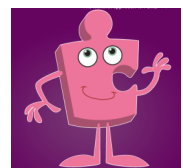

PSHE



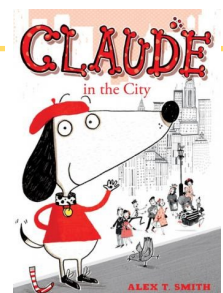
In PSHE we will be thinking about 'Changes in me'. Jo will be helping us to learn about the changes we go through in our lives and focusing on how our bodies change.

Can you think of 3 changes that have happened to you since you were born?

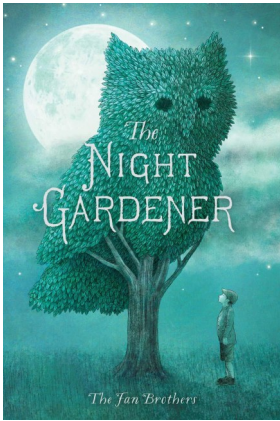


What are the teachers reading?
